

EXECUTIVE SOLUTION BRIEF

Govern what AI can execute.

AI can propose. You govern execution.

What VibePackr actually does

VibePackr governs what AI can execute. For supported work routed through VibePackr, it checks the required authority, scope and policy before execution, then validates what happened and records the outcome for review. It does not govern every enterprise action. [1]

A proposal is not permission

A proposed action must be considered against its purpose, permitted operations, target and data scope, applicable policy and required approval. Permitted work follows the controlled path. If not permitted, that request does not execute. Capability or identity alone does not grant authority. [2]

Execution is not acceptance

Validation checks the observed outcome against defined criteria. Failed execution, failed validation and incomplete evidence are not success. Evidence and a technical receipt support review; responsible human acceptance remains separate. [3]

Governed AI Execution for Enterprise Work

This is execution governance for supported Work, not a replacement for the enterprise stack. BT-OS and the protected Packr Engine explain the architecture behind the function. Existing applications, IAM, gateways, models and their owners remain relevant. Customer-controlled, single-tenant headless deployment remains a target model, not completed customer or Google Cloud deployment evidence. [4]

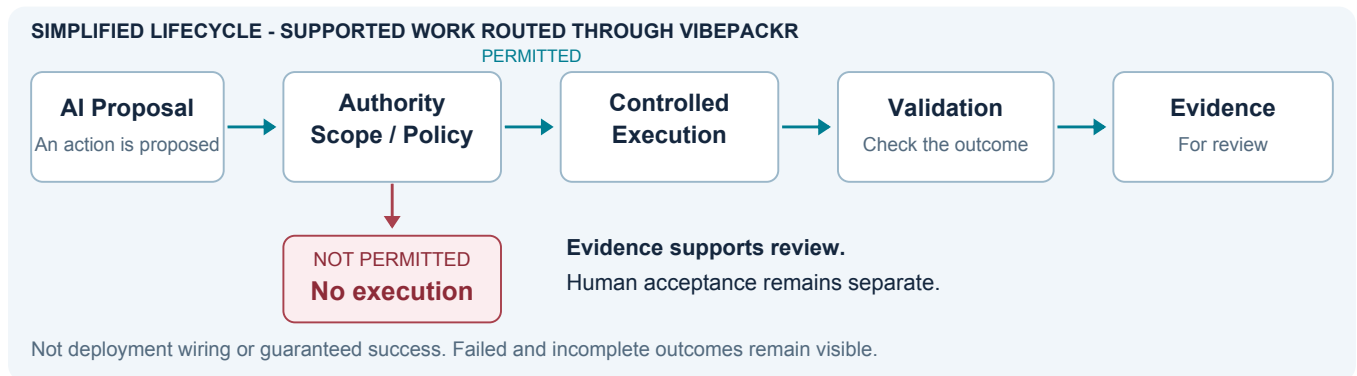
Scope note: bounded-current means the reviewed technical scope, not that every depicted combination is integrated, released or supported in a customer environment. Confirm the selected versions, interfaces and permitted operations. [Source: p. 2]

EXECUTIVE ARCHITECTURE

What VibePackr includes. Distinct responsibilities.

Permission before execution. Evidence before acceptance.



Define & Prepare

Contract captures technical intent, constraints and scope. Document support carries reviewed material and its identity into Work preparation. Document Supporter is a role here, not an established standalone module. Neither grants authority. [6]

Understand & Integrate

GAPE adds scoped Git/Rust/Tauri static source discovery, snapshot reconciliation and offline viewers. Helper R2 uses an exact GAPE snapshot plus independent bindings to prepare plans, not activate connections. Historical SDK Engine implementation exists; current full Enterprise integration and support remain unestablished. These are optional capabilities, not a mandatory pipeline. [7]

Govern & Execute; operate through distinct surfaces

Packr Engine owns protected decisions for supported Work. Headless and PackrGUI expose machine and human paths; VMAdmin and PacktoryAdmin have bounded admin scopes. Validation and technical evidence do not replace human acceptance. Local Packtory is distinct from future hosted sharing; Remote Rescue remains disabled. [5]

Capability ≠ Authority. Declaration ≠ Discovery ≠ Preparation ≠ Registration ≠ Binding ≠ Authority ≠ Execution. [Source: pp. 4, 9, 16]

ENTERPRISE EVALUATION

Start with one bounded Work. Decide from the evidence.

A common product with explicit customer responsibilities.

Choose a useful question and define the limit

For example, an enterprise may evaluate a report produced from one authorized source for a specified period and recipient. Define permitted transformations, exclusions, owners, interfaces and acceptance criteria first. This is an illustrative evaluation, not a certified reporting workflow or connector claim. [8]

Evaluate the boundary as well as success

Examine a permitted request, denied scope or missing approval, unavailable prerequisites, failed validation and incomplete evidence. If recovery or reuse is relevant, establish the conditions and authority for that separate exercise. Record what was actually tested, what failed and what remains unproven. A technical pass is not release approval or production acceptance. [9]

Productized Assistance, not automatic SI delivery

Standardized functions and guidance can assist preparation, evaluation and operation. Customer-specific adapters, migrations, workflow design, infrastructure operation and final business decisions retain named owners. Non-SI does not mean zero integration effort, and it does not exclude included product defects from applicable support scope. Executed agreements and applicable law govern obligations. [10]

Measure value before expanding scope

Compare like-for-like scope and evidence against a real baseline. Include implementation effort, review and exception handling, runtime and infrastructure costs, operator effort and any authorized recovery exercise. The source supplies no assumed savings or guaranteed ROI. Proceed, continue evaluating or decline the scope according to the evidence and responsible decisions. [11]
